
Sub: Cut-off date of BIS licence for eligibility for award of Rate Contract – reg.

The following amendments in Para 13.12.1 of DGS&D Manual are hereby authorized with immediate effect:

"In respect of items being brought on rate contract to supply with ISI Marking and items which are to be supplied with ISI marking under Compulsory Certification Scheme of the Bureau of Indian Standards as per list being brought out by them from time to time, the responding tenderer should possess valid BIS licence to supply the items with ISI marking. Firms should be eligible for award of Rate Contract and also to continue on Rate Contract when they are in possession of valid BIS licence at all times during the entire period of Rate Contract apart from having it on the date of award of Rate Contract.

The time period for submission of BIS Licence would be 45 days from the date of tender opening."

2. The above shall be effective mutatis mutandis to DGS&D Manual dated 01.10.1999, DGS&D 68 (Revised) and DGS&D 1001.
